Turkish tanks thwart PYD/PKK attack in Afrin



Turkish forces target truck advancing towards Free Syrian Army position

AFRIN - Turkish Armed Forces on Wednesday thwarted a PYD/PKK terror attack targeting a Free Syrian Army (FSA) position in Syria's northwestern Afrin region.

Turkish tanks struck down an explosive-laden truck advancing towards an FSA position after the troops spotted it through thermal cameras. Anadolu Agency also

filmed the military action carried out on a strategic hill in the west of Afrin. On Jan. 20, Turkey along with the FSA launched Operation Olive Branch to clear PYD/PKK and Daesh terrorists from Afrin. Colombia, Haiti, Argentina, Chile, Peru, Bolivia, Ecuador and Uruguay as part of the campaign "Let my gift be the Quran" -- had a Spanish translation side by side with the original Arabic. Ankara 'meets' EU benchmarks on visa free regime

ANKARA - Turkish EU Affairs Minister Omer Celik said Wednesday that Ankara had finalized a draft document for Turkish citizens to travel to Schengen countries visa-free and would be submitting it to the EU Commission soon. visa liberalization]. These documents will be submitted to the EU Commission very soon."

Merkel, SPD agree on coalition government

BERLIN - German Chancellor Angela Merkel's conservative bloc and the Social Democrats have agreed to form a "grand coalition" government after 136 days of political stalemate, media reported on Wednesday. **Leaders of the Christian** democratic bloc (CDU/CSU) and the Social Democratic Party (SPD) have reached a breakthrough after marathon talks that started Tuesday morning, German news agency

DPA reported. The SPD, which had been reluctant to enter a new coalition with conservatives, is expected to hold key ministerial posts, including foreign, finance and labor, according to the reports. Merkel's Bavarian ally Christian Social Union (CSU) secured four ministries, including the Interior.

The coalition deal is still subject to approval by the SPD's around 460,000 members. The SPD's traditional... MORE DETAILS
